Lenten Devotional Sessions (AKA Soup and Scripture) - Good news! We will again be offering a Lenten series as we did last year. But...this year we will be offering a luncheon at Noon on Wednesdays, AND a light supper on Thursdays at 6:00PM. We're hoping that those who could not attend because of work obligations last year can attend the Thursday offering. The series will be Opening ourselves to Grace: Basic Christian Practices.
